ORIGINS AND BIBLICAL CONNECTIONS

IN BIBLICAL LITERATURE, THE TERM "CHILDREN OF ADAM" REFERS TO THE DESCENDANTS OF THE FIRST MAN, ADAM, SYMBOLIZING ALL HUMANKIND.
